

Nowadays Urgench State University pays great attention to eradication sexual and physical abuse, human rights abuses, insults, and any other violations of human rights, and takes the necessary measures.

Adequate information is provided to university staff and students and the right to self-defense is explained by experts. To date, there have been no incidents of aggression by staff or foreign nationals at the University, and adequate measures have been taken to prevent this. The women's department and psychologists interview the students to study their problems and give them the right advice.

If this happens at the University, it will protect the victim, the aggrieved citizen, and ensure that the aggrieved citizen is held accountable before the law. At the same time, the victim will be provided with all possible assistance and his dignity will be protected.

Uzbekistan has enacted laws to protect women.



Article 4. The rights of the victim of oppression and violence

Victims of harassment and violence have the following rights:

- applying to the relevant competent authorities and organizations or to the court with a complaint about the use or threat of pressure and violence against him;
- free legal advice, economic, social, psychological, medical and other assistance in special centers, as well as through a free telephone line;
- apply to the law enforcement agencies for a protection order, and in case of violation of the terms of the protection order, notify them;
- applying to the court for compensation for material damage caused to him as a result of pressure and violence, as well as compensation for non-pecuniary damage.
- the victim of oppression and violence is exempted from paying state duties when he / she applies to the court with a claim for compensation for material damage and non-pecuniary damage.
