Gender equality policy is implemented at the University level and the University Women's Committee advises staff and students on all aspects of gender policy and educates them on their rights. Section 10 Article 46 of the Constitution of the Republic of Uzbekistan stipulates that "women and men have equal rights" and those who violate this law will be held accountable within the framework of the law. The University will work on this basis and will take the necessary measures.



Currently, every faculty of the University holds weekly student meetings and provides enough information. In addition, students submit their articles on gender equality to faculty leaders in writing and are consulted on all aspects of gender policy.



Core principle:

1. The interests of both sexes must be optimally ensured at all levels. This includes equal representation in all working conditions, as well as due consideration of any specific gender interests.
2. The University supports forms of employment that allow staff and students to combine work or study with family responsibilities. The university creates conditions for staff and students to take care of children.
3. Everyone should be respected, regardless of their origin, circumstances or lifestyle.
4. There should be an equal relationship between men and women at the university.
5. The staff of the Gender Equality Commission advises students on all issues of gender policy.
