

Today, Uzbekistan has taken strict measures to combat forced labor. It is composed of representatives of various government agencies involved in the fight against forced labor by the decree of the President of Republic of Uzbekistan.

The National Commission on Combating Trafficking in Persons and Forced Labor and its subcommittees on combating forced labor have been established. At the same time, Urgench State University has taken strong measures to combat forced labor. According to the decree it is impossible to force staff and students into any type of forced labor out of the official contract.



Regardless of the order in which the Hashar (traditional type of cleaning by volunteers) has been organized at the university, which has become a tradition in Uzbekistan, it is considered forced labor. Therefore, not every worker and student is involved in extracurricular activities.
